- · On the first day of class, ALL Swimmers in Advanced Beginner and Intermediate Levels will be tested. If they are not ready for that level, they will be asked to exit the water, if the appropriate swim level is unavailable, they will be moved into that class. If the level needed is full a REFUND will be issued.
- At the end of each class, swimmers will dry off, gather their belonging and a staff member will walk them to the Southeast gate for parent pick up.
- Lesson Check-In: On the first day of each session please check in at the "Check-In Table" to get the name of your child's instructor. When checking in for session II & III, & IV, it is the PARENTS' RESPONSIBILITY to inform the check-in staff of the student moving to the next level. ### **CLASS LEVELS**

We offer a variety of the following class levels each ½ hour long.

### MOM or DAD & ME

(Infant & Pre-school Aquatics). Children of pre-school age are introduced to the water through this course. Parents participate in the water with the youngster. Class is taught by a Water Safety Instructor. Infants must be at least 6 months to 3 years of age.

MUST WEAR SWIM DIAPER 5 Students per class.

### TINY TOTS, LEVEL 2 (Primary Skills)

This class is designed for children 3 to 5 years of age. Emphasis is placed on water adjustment and fundamental skills. Students will learn to kick and move their arms together. 5 students per class.

### **BEGINNER LEVEL 3**

The objective of this class is to teach students who may be a little timid about the water, but are more advanced than the Tiny Tots Level. Students will be introduced to the front crawl, floating & fully submerging into the water. 5 years & up. 4-5 students per class.

### **ADVANCED BEGINNERS, LEVEL 4**

This class is designed to develop confidence in the strokes previously learned, and to improve other aquatic skills.
